INTRODUCTION.

The publishers herewith offer to the public a collection of INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC, the melodies of which have been taken from among the most popular operatic and other music of the day, and arranged in an easy and correct manner, as Solos, Duetts, Trios, and Quartets, suitable for serenades, evenings at home, &c. Having long noticed the want of such a work, they have determined to issue one that will meet with general approbation, and have accordingly confided the task of selecting and arranging the melodies to a gentleman of acknowledged musical taste, and composer of some of the most popular airs ever written in this or any other country, as will be seen by reference to the name on the title page.

In the Trios and Quartets the Bass part is primarily intended for the Violoncello, though in its absence any other Bass instrument may be used, in many of the pieces, with the proper transpositions, and where both the Bass and second Violin are wanting, the parts written for them can be performed on the Piano-Forte, with good effect.
